The Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) is a charge levied on developers wishing to build new homes in an area. The charge depends on the number of homes built and can be used to improve local infrastructure and facilities. Under current arrangements, if the Neighbourhood Plan is adopted, we might expect to receive 25% of the CIL; this could be approximately £85k per 100 homes built.
