

# WEST LINDSEY DISTRICT COUNCIL

## BYELAW

For the Good Rule and Government of the District of West Lindsey and for the prevention of nuisances, made by the Council of the District in pursuance of Section 235 of the Local Government Act, 1972.

1. This Byelaw shall extend and apply only to the Parishes in the District listed in the First Schedule hereto.

### Dogs Fouling Footways or Grass Verges

2. No person in charge of a dog shall allow the dog to foul a footway or grass verge (being a footway or grass verge to which this Byelaw applies) by depositing its excrement thereon.

This Byelaw applies to

- (a) the footway of any street or public place; and
- (b) a grass verge which is not more than three metres wide and is
  - (i) adjacent to the carriageway or footway of a highway; and
  - (ii) managed by a Local Authority and maintained in good order.

3. For the purposes of this Byelaw the owner of the dog shall be deemed in charge thereof, unless the Court is satisfied that at the time the dog fouled the footway or grass verge it had been placed in or taken into the charge of some other person.

### Penalty Clause

4. Any person offending against this Byelaw shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding Fifty pounds.

### Revocation Clause

5. All Good Rule and Government Byelaws in respect of dogs fouling footways and as listed in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby repealed.

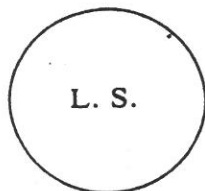
